AN ACT Relating to Power of Arrest by Chief Forest Fire Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 103, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 103 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘He shall investigate and gather evidence regarding the causes of forest fires, enforce all laws relating to forests and forest preservation, arrest all violators thereof, and violators of chapter 137, section 18, relating to the depositing of rubbish on another’s land and chapter 141, section 11, relating to the depositing of domestic waste in waters, prosecute all offenses against the same, and in this connection shall have the same power to serve criminal processes against such offenders and shall be allowed the same fee as a sheriff or his deputy for like services, and shall have and enjoy the same right as a sheriff to require aid in executing the duties of his office.’
