**AN ACT Prohibiting the Transfer of Registration of Vehicles to Defeat Purpose  
of Financial Responsibility Law.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 22, § 81, sub-§ VIII, additional.** Section 81 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection VIII, to read as follows :

**‘VIII. Transfer of registration to defeat purpose.** If an owner’s registration has been suspended hereunder, such registration shall not be transferred nor the vehicle in respect to which such registration was issued or any other vehicle owned by him be registered in any other name until the Secretary of State is satisfied that such transfer of registration is proposed in good faith and not for the purpose or with the effect of defeating the purposes of sections 75 to 82.

Nothing in this subsection shall in any way affect the rights of any conditional vendor, chattel mortgagee or lessor of such a vehicle registered in the name of another as owner who becomes subject to sections 75 to 82.

The Secretary of State shall suspend the registration of any vehicle transferred in violation of this subsection.’
