COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 227, L. D. 297, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Minimum Wages for Firemen."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line the following underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec.1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Sec. 2 Effective date. This act shall become effective
May 1, 1964 unless in any city a majority of the legal voters,
present and voting, at any regular election vote against the
act and unless in any town an article in a town warrant so
providing shall have been voted against at an annual town
meeting. The question in appropriate terms may be submitted
to the voters at any regular city election by the municipal
officers thereof and shall be so submitted upon petition of at
least 10% of the number of voters voting for the gubernatorial
candidates at the last statewide election in that municipality.
Such petition shall be filed with the municipal officers at
least 30 days before such regular election.'
