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**AN ACT Relating to Minimum Wages for Firemen.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 30, § 132-B, sub-§ VII, additional.** Section 132-B of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 362 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VII, to read as follows :

**‘VII. Minimum wage for firemen. Members of municipal fire fighting departments, other than volunteer or call-departments, who are paid salaries or regular wages, are deemed to be employees within the meaning of this section, are covered by this chapter and their pay is subject to these minimum wage laws.’**
