STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Organization of Police Department of City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 1, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1 of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

'The commission shall appoint a chief of police, and it may appoint 3 captains of police, one captain of detectives, 3 4 lieutenants of police, one of which will be designated as the juvenile officer, 4 sergeants of police, and one identification officer, one police matron, one police clerk and such number of patrolmen, not to exceed one for each 900 of the population of the city, as the commission shall deem necessary, the entire personnel of which, as existing when this charter takes effect, shall continue subject to the provisions hereinafter contained.'
