**AN ACT Relating to Taking of Smelts from Chandler River,
Washington County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 144, amended. The first paragraph of section 144 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959, as repealed and replaced by chapter 47 of the private and special laws of 1961, is amended to read as follows:

‘Smelts may be taken from the tidal waters of the Towns of Addison, Columbia Falls, Cherryfield, Harrington, Milbridge and Steuben **and from that part of Chandler River located in the Town of Jonesboro**, all in the County of Washington, in the following manner: By hook and line, gill nets, hand dip nets, brush weirs and bag nets, from March 15th to April 30th of each year.’
