## AN ACT Increasing Excise Tax on House Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 91-A, § 124, sub-§ I, ¶ B, amended.** Paragraph B of subsection I of section 124 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 308 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

**'B.** House trailers. For the privilege of operating a house trailer upon the public ways, each house trailer to be so operated shall be subject to such excise tax as follows: A sum equal to 20 35 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the first or current year of model,  $\frac{16}{30}$  mills for the 2nd year,  $\frac{12}{30}$  25 mills for the 3rd year and  $\frac{16}{30}$  20 mills for the 4th year and succeeding years. The minimum tax shall be  $\frac{16}{30}$
