AN ACT Relating to Investigations of Hunting Accidents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 147, repealed and replaced. Section 147 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

“Sec. 147. Investigation of hunting accidents. Whoever knows of the wounding or killing of a human being as set forth in section 146 shall forthwith report the same to the sheriff of the county where the accident occurred or the State Police who shall investigate and report the findings to the county attorney.”
