AN ACT Relating to Time and Penalty for Dogs Running at Large.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 96-A, amended. Section 96-A of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 96-A. Dogs running at large.** From ~~February~~ **December** 1st to April 30th of ~~each the following~~ calendar year it shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to permit said dog to roam-at-large in any area frequented by deer. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~\$10~~ **\$25** nor more than ~~\$50~~ **\$100**, and costs, ~~which fine and costs shall not be suspended.~~'
