## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Titles by Unregistered Persons in Practice of Architecture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 8, amended. The first paragraph of section 8 of chapter 81 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'In order to safeguard life, health and property, no person shall practice architecture or hold himself out to practice architecture within the State or use the title "architect" or call himself an architect, architectural designer or any other qualifying words or phrases, or any other derivative of the word architect or sign drawings or specifications as an architect, unless he shall be duly registered by the board in the manner herein provided and shall thereafter comply with the provisions of this chapter.'
