## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of Certain Codes in Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, § 3, amended. The first sentence of the next to the last paragraph of section 3 of chapter 90-A, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'The municipality shall provide a penalty of not more than \$100 plus costs for the violation of any ordinance authorized by this section, but such penalty shall not apply to the violation of any building, electrical, housing or plumbing code.'
