**AN ACT Relating to Pollution of Waters Forming an International Boundary.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 79, § 2-B, additional.** Chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2-B, to read as follows:

**‘Sec. 2-B. Waters forming an international boundary. With respect to waters forming an international boundary, the Water Improvement Commission shall require of municipalities, industries, agencies and others discharging waste to such international waters pollution control and abatement consistent with water quality which must be maintained to fulfill requirements of international treaties.’**
