RESOLVE, for Removal of Old Bridge Across Mattawamkeag River in Haynesville.

Removal of old bridge across Mattawamkeag River in Haynesville. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission is authorized to remove the old bridge across the Mattawamkeag River in Haynesville Village, this bridge being located on a road which was formerly a part of U. S. Route 2-A in Haynesville Village.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

That section of U. S. Route 2-A in Haynesville Village in which the bridge across the Mattawamkeag River is located has been reconstructed and there is no further use for the old bridge which was not dismantled at the time the new bridge was constructed. The old bridge must now either be dismantled or a considerable sum of money expended for maintenance. In view of the fact that the highway facilities are adequate without use of the old bridge, it is believed desirable that the old bridge be dismantled.
