STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Promoting New Industrial Plant Locations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38-A, § 5, sub-§ VII, additional. Section 5 of chapter 38-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VII, to read as follows:
 - 'VII. Industrial plant locations. Promote, on a matching fund basis with local area or regional industrial groups, through advertising or other means, the favorable factors concerning such area as a site for new plant locations and growing industry.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
