STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Size of Salmon taken from Waters of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 45, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 45 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No person shall have in his possession at any time, except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 9:

- I. A salmon or togue less than 14 inches in length taken from any of the waters of the State except Aroostook County, and 12 inches in length taken from any of the waters in Aroostook County;
- II. A trout less than 6 inches in length;
- III. A black bass less than 10 inches in length.'
- Sec. 2. Limitation. This act shall remain in effect only until October 1, 1965.
