STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 90-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 90-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 90-A. Closed season on bears. There shall be a closed season for the hunting or trapping of black bear during the months of January, February and March of each year.'
