STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Use of Power Boats on Tim Pond and Mud Pond, Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 67, amended. Section 67 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'No person shall operate any boat or canoe propelled by motor on Tim Pond and Mud Pond, in T. 2, R. 4, Franklin County.'
