STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Definition of "Hotel" Under Liquor Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 1, amended. The 4th sentence of the 10th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the definition of "Hotel," is amended to read as follows:

'Each such hotel shall be open for the convenience of the traveling public 7 days per week and a reasonable proportion I/3 of the gross income of each such hotel shall be derived from rental of rooms and sale of food.'
