AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave for Members of Police Department of City of
Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 16-A, amended. Section 16-A of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 126 of the private and special laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 16-A. Sick leave. Members of the police department shall be allowed to accumulate ~~one day~~ **1 1/2 days** of sick leave ~~for every 30 days per month~~ worked, a total of ~~12~~ **18** days per year, accumulating to ~~50~~ **70** days. At the termination of employment of the member, he shall have no claim, monetary or other compensation, for any unused portion of days allowed for sick leave.'
