SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 313, L. D. 406, Bill, "An Act Increasing Sales Tax."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 3, a new section as follows:

"Sec. 4. R. S., c. 17, §37, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 37 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: 'The retailer shall may add the amount of the tax on such property and may state the amount of the taxes separately from the price of such property on all price display signs, sales or delivery slips, bills and statements which advertise or indicate the price of such property or may include the sale tax in the price of the property and may advertise that he is absorbing the tax.' "

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 4 to be section 5.
