RESOLVE, Providing Funds to Aid Existing Maine Business to Find Foreign Markets.

Appropriation; Department of Economic Development. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to the Department of Economic Development to help existing business to find foreign markets for their products as provided in the Revised Statutes, chapter 38-A, section 5, subsection VI.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this resolve is to set up within the framework of the Department of Economic Development an overseas marketing service for Maine manufactured goods.
