STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Stocking Baxter State Park with Caribou.

Baxter State Park; stocked with caribou. Resolved: That the sum of \$8,000 be appropriated to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the purchase of 20 caribou by the State of Maine from the Province of Newfoundland, said caribou to be imported and released in Baxter State Park. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Game shall act as the representative of the State of Maine for the accomplishment of this project.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

By stocking Baxter State Park with caribou the State would be promoting an additional recreational asset for the tourist business.
