RESOLVE, in Favor of Kermit O. Stadig of Soldier Pond.

Appropriation for; Kermit O. Stadig. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$7,400 to be paid to Kermit O. Stadig of Soldier Pond, doing business as Valley Contractors, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss on contract to renovate Fort Kent State Teachers' College.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Stadig was low bidder to renovate the laboratory school at Fort Kent State Teachers' College in the amount of \$18,081. He began work on July 21, 1961 and completed the renovation in January 1962. He lost \$7,400 on the work.
