# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Authorizing Bureau of Public Improvements to Study Desirability of a Dam Across Bagaduce River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Study. The Bureau of Public Improvements of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a dam with spillway across the Bagaduce River between the Town of Brooksville and the Town of Castine, in the County of Hancock.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Bureau of Public Improvements from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,200 from which the Bureau of Public Improvements may spend such amounts as shall equal any sums which may be appropriated by any municipality in Hancock County or donated by any individual, corporation or foundation to carry out the purposes of this study.

Sec. 3. Donations. The Bureau of Public Improvements is authorized to accept from any individual, corporation or foundation such donations as may be made for completing said study.

Sec. 4. Report. The Bureau of Public Improvements shall report the results of its study to the next regular session of the Legislature.
