AN ACT Authorizing Bureau of Public Improvements to Study Desirability of a Dam Across Taunton River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. I. Study of desirability of a dam across Taunton River authorized. The Bureau of Public Improvements of the Department of Finance and Administration is authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a dam with spillway across the Taunton River between the Town of Sullivan and the Town of Hancock, in the County of Hancock.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Bureau of Public Improvements from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,250 from which the Bureau of Public Improvements may spend such amounts as shall equal any sums which may be appropriated by any municipality in Hancock County or donated by any individual, corporation or foundation to carry out the purposes of this study.
- Sec. 3. May accept donations, etc. The Bureau of Public Improvements is authorized to accept from any individual, corporation or foundation such donations as may be made for completing said study.
- Sec. 4. Report to Legislature. The Bureau of Public Improvements shall report the results of its study to the next regular session of the Legislature.
