**AN ACT Relating to Expending Aroostook County Funds for Renovating the
Terminal at Presque Isle Municipal Airport.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Presque Isle Municipal Airport is the only commercial airport serving northern Aroostook County; and

Whereas, extensive renovations to the terminal building at said airport are urgently needed for the convenience and safety of travelers; and

Whereas, the City of Presque Isle is unable to assume the entire expense of said renovations; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for renovating the terminal at Presque Isle Municipal Airport. Aroostook County shall expend the sum of \$19,500 for renovating the terminal building at Presque Isle Municipal Airport, to be paid to the treasurer of the City of Presque Isle within 60 days after this act shall take effect, and to be expended by the City of Presque Isle for the renovation of said terminal building, or to reimburse the City of Presque Isle if such renovation shall have been accomplished.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
