STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959 and as amended by section 1 of chapter 390 of the public laws of 1961, which relates to Lincoln County, is further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln County: County commissioners, \$900 \$1,000; chairman \$1,100; clerk of courts, \$3,800 \$4,500; county attorney, \$3,000 \$3,500; county treasurer, \$1,000; sheriff, \$3,300 \$3,800; register of deeds, \$3,850 \$4,350; judge of probate, \$3,700 \$3,500; register of probate, \$3,800; Lincoln municipal court judge, \$3,000; recorder, \$2,000.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963, the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to provide for increase in the salary of the county attorney of Lincoln County. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1963.
