STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Promoting Scenic Attractions and Vacation Facilities in Maine

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38-A, § 6, sub-§ IV, additional. Section 6 of chapter 38-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 471 of the public laws of 1955, is amended by adding a new subsection IV, to read as follows:
 - 'IV. Scenic attractions; vacation facilities. Promote, on a matching fund basis with area chambers of commerce, or other travel promotion groups, by advertising or other means, the assets of a particular area, such as scenic attractions, vacation facilities and other items of interest to the traveling public.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
