STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing a Pension for Margaret H. Frisbee of Belfast.

Margaret H. Frisbee; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$60 per month be granted to Margaret H. Frisbee of Belfast, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1963, and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Margaret Frisbee is 27 years of age and mentally retarded. Her parents are dead and she is now living with an uncle.
