RESOLVE, in Favor of Lloyd Talbot of Portland.

Lloyd Talbot; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$272.55 to be paid to Lloyd Talbot, of Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for destruction of his car by 3 escapees from the Boys Training Center in South Portland.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On February 23, 1961, 3 escapees from the Boys Training Center at South Portland, at approximately 10 A. M., took the motor vehicle owned by Lloyd Talbot from Somerset Street in said city. The car was parked on Somerset Street while Mr. Talbot was at work. The ignition of the vehicle was locked and the escapees crossed the wires in order to start the car. The escapees hit another car and caused considerable damage to Mr. Talbot's car. The damage was estimated at \$350 but Mr. Talbot is asking for only \$272.55.
