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**AN ACT Relating to Redistribution of Axle Loads on Commercial Vehicles.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 111, amended.** Section 111 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the first paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘When a duly qualified officer of the Maine State Police determines that a vehicle is in violation of the axle weight limits of this chapter but is within the legal gross maximum weight limits, the driver shall be permitted before proceeding to redistribute the weight so that no axle is overweight, in which event there is no violation and no fine shall be assessed.’
