STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Kennebago River, Franklin County.

Fishing in Kennebago River; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation regulating fishing in Kennebago River, Franklin County, as follows:

Open to fly fishing only from Big Island Pond to Little Kennebago Lake, daily limit of 5 fish;

From Little Kennebago Lake to Big Kennebago Lake, open until September 30th, fly fishing only, daily limit of 5 fish, all tributaries closed;

From outlet of Big Kennebago Lake, down to the second dam, open until September 30th, fly fishing only, daily limit of 5 fish;

Below second dam, fly fishing only, open until September 30th, daily limit of one fish, tributaries closed.
