## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Long Pond, Sandy River Plantation, Franklin County.

Fishing in Long Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Long Pond, Sandy River Plantation, Franklin County, to fishing under the general laws except that the use or possession of live fish as bait is prohibited, and with a daily limit of 5 fish.
