IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Franklin County.

Fishing in certain waters in Franklin County, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations opening Rangeley, Cupsuptic, Mooselookmeguntic, Kennebago, Little Kennebago and Loon Lakes and Dodge, Quimby, Long and Gull Ponds to fly fishing only through October 15th of each year and establishing a bag limit of one fish per day.
