STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Certain Construction at Augusta State Airport.

Construction at Augusta State Airport; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund a sum not in excess of \$713,000 for such construction at the Augusta State Airport as may be recommended by the Aeronautics Commission and approved by the Governor and Council. The expenditure shall be under the supervision of the Aeronautics Commission. Such expenditure as may be authorized by this resolve shall be contingent upon the fact that not more than 50% of the project cost shall be paid for by funds herein appropriated. It is the intent of the Legislature to so limit the use of state funds as to require that federal funds and other funds shall finance 50% of the cost of the project; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse, but shall be carried forward to the 1964-1965 fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose is to improve Augusta State Airport to provide a suitable runway for air carrier service into central Maine. The complete project will consist of:

Extend runway 17-35 \$850,000
Construct 3,000' of pavement 300,000
Install 3,000' of runway lights 8,000

Reconstruct 800' of access road		\$	16,000
R. E. I. L. lights (2 sets)			5,000
Engineering 10%			117,900
Contingencies 10%			129,100
