RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Maranacook Lake, Kennebec County.

Fishing in Maranacook Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Maranacook Lake, in the Towns of Winthrop and Readfield, Kennebec County, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st; and opening said lake to ice fishing for all fish, except bass, during February and March; and establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout, salmon and togue in the aggregate.
