STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Sewage Treatment Plant and Purchase of Equipment at Gorham State Teachers College.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a sewage disposal plant must be in operation before a new dormitory for men and the new health and physical education building at Gorham State Teachers College can be accepted; and

Whereas, equipment must be purchased and installed in the new health and physical education building at Gorham State Teachers College before classes can be conducted therein; and

Whereas, approximately 6 months are required for such construction and purchase; and

Whereas, occupancy and use of the 2 buildings are needed in September, 1963; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for necessary construction of a sewage disposal plant and purchase of equipment at Gorham State Teachers College. In order to provide for

the necessary construction of a sewage disposal plant and purchase of equipment for classes at Gorham State Teachers College, there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$127,700 to the Department of Education. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the projects authorized by this appropriation have been completed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
