HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 416, L.D. 569, Resolve, Authorizing the Establishment of a Residential and Day School for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by adding at the end before the period the following 'and Appropriating Funds for the Hope School for the Mentally Retarded in Mexico'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting after the 4th paragraph the following paragraphs:

'Whereas, there is already established in Mexico, Oxford County, the Hope School for the Mentally Retarded; and

Whereas, the school is presently financed by county funds and donations; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that further aid be granted to said school; and'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end of the schedule and before the emergency clause the following:

'; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund of the State the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30,1965, to the Hope School for the Mentally Retarded in Mexico, Oxford County, for the education and training for the mentally retarded.'
