HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 416, L.D. 569, Resolve, Authorizing the Establishment of a Residential and Day School for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by adding at the end, before the period, the words 'and Appropriating Funds for Oxford County for Education Programs for Retarded Children'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting after the 4th paragraph, the following paragraph:

'Whereas, to provide aid for educational programs for retarded children in Oxford County is vitally necessary; and'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end of the schedule, before the emergency clause, the following: '; and be it further

Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$12,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and \$12,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to Oxford County to reimburse the county for education of retarded children as provided by the Revised Statutes, chapter 89, section 16-C, as enacted by the public laws of 1963, chapter 154.'
