RESOLVE, to Reimburse Harry F. Sanborn, West Baldwin, for Loss of Pullets.

Harry F. Sanborn; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$360 to reimburse Harry F. Sanborn of West Baldwin as a full and final settlement against the State for loss of pullets killed by raccoons.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In June, 1961, 200 pullets belonging to Mr. Sanborn were killed by raccoons. The loss was not reported by the selectmen of the Town of West Baldwin so that Mr. Sanborn was unable to be reimbursed by the State.
