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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Asa Averill of Belgrade.**

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**Mrs. Asa Averill; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$750 to compensate Mrs. Asa Averill of Belgrade for damages to her well by the addition of harmful salt content resulting in harmful chloride content.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Damage was done to Mrs. Asa Averill's well by construction project F-032-1 (1). One of the greatest items of damage is the change in the nature of the water in her well. The water now has a salt taste and actual chloride content. This is due to the Highway Commission plowing snow back from the highway to such a location that they put all the drainage from the snow and salt adjacent to the well thus causing the chloride content. Mrs. Averill is unable to use the well because of the chloride content.
