COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 384, L. D. 583, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Appointment of Chief Engineer of Fire Department
of City of Westbrook."

Amend said Bill by striking out the first 3 lines and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'P. & S. L., 1907, c. 257, §30-A, additional. Chapter 257
of the private and special laws of 1907 is amended by adding a
new section 30-A, to read as follows:'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line by striking out the
underlined figure and letter "19-A" and inserting in place thereof
the underlined figure and letter "30-A"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 12th line
the underlined figure "2/3" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined word 'majority'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the single quotation
mark at the end of the 12th line and by adding a new paragraph
to read as follows:

"Upon the death, resignation or removal from office of such
appointee, a new appointment shall be made to fill such vacancy
as soon as practicable in accordance with this section; but the
mayor may fill such vacancy by an appointment pro tem for a period
not in excess of 6 months, which term shall expire when such new
appointment is made as provided for. The compensation of such
appointee shall be fixed by the council but shall not be increased
or diminished during the municipal year in which the compensation
is fixed. Such officer shall perform all the duties prescribed by
the laws of this State and city ordinances for his respective office
and such other duties not inconsistent with the nature of his
offices as the mayor or city council may from time to time
prescribe."
