# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Registrar of Voters of Town of Rumford Holding Other Town Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1951, c. 45, Art. XXII, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of article XXII of chapter 45 of the private and special laws of 1951 is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Duplication in officers. No town official, either elected or appointed, shall hold more than one town office at a time, except that the offices of clerk and, treasurer and registrar of voters may be held concurrently by the same person, and except as otherwise provided by Article XX, section I, of this act.'
