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**AN ACT** Relating to Registrar of Voters of Town of Rumford Holding Other  
Town Offices.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1951, c. 45, Art. XXII, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of article XXII of chapter 45 of the private and special laws of 1951 is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 2. Duplication in officers.** No town official, either elected or appointed, shall hold more than one town office at a time, except that the offices of clerk ~~and~~, treasurer ~~and~~ registrar of voters may be held concurrently by the same person, and except as otherwise provided by Article XX, section 1, of this act.'
