STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Classifying Part of Medomak River and Certain Waters
In and Bordering Waldoboro.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 15, amended. Subsection XLV of that part of section 15 of chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes under the capition "Kennebec River Basin and Adjacent Coastal Areas," which was enacted by section 1 of chapter 426 of the public laws of 1955, is repealed as follows:
 - 'XLV. Medomak River, main stem, from a point 400 feet above the Route + bridge in Waldoboro to the head of tide Class C.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 15, amended. Subsections XII and XIII of that part of section 15 of chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes under the caption "Lincoln County from the Town Line Between Edgecomb and Boothbay to the Knox County Boundary", which were enacted by section 9 of chapter 322 of the public laws of 1957, are amended to read as follows:
 - 'XH. Tidewater of the Town of Waldoboro from the head of tide on the Medomak River to the first narrowing of the river at approximately latitude 44° 05' N. Class C.
 - XIII. Tidewaters bordering Waldoboro north of a line drawn from Haffses Point to Waltz Point except that designated as Class "C"—Class B-1.'
