COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 392, L. D. 591, Bill, "An Act
to Incorporate the West Paris Water District."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 2 the following:
'For the purpose of further carrying out this section the
said district may purchase water from any source within a
radius of 8 miles from the said district and may take by
purchase or otherwise any real estate or interest therein for
the production of water or essential for erecting dams, reservoirs
or for preserving the purity or quantity of the water and for
laying and maintaining aqueducts and pipes for the taking,
conveying, discharging and disposing of said water and said
district is further authorized to acquire by purchase or other-
wise any existing water system or rights which may be available
for the purposes contained herein.

The said district shall be liable for all damages sustained
by any person, corporation, state or political subdivision
thereof or thereby in the operation of said district. If the
amount of the damages cannot be mutually agreed upon, then the
claimant may cause his damages to be ascertained in the manner
prescribed in the case of damages in laying out highways.'
