STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Mileage Allowance for State Employees on State Business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 44, amended. The first sentence of section 44 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 and as amended by section 13 of chapter 429, both of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'The State shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the State in the business of the State not more than $\frac{8}{90}$ gc per mile for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any one fiscal year, and $\frac{6}{90}$ for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles, except that the State shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes or table stock potatoes 8c for every mile so travelled.'

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
