COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 220, L. D. 605, Bill, "An Act
Revising Laws for Registration and Licensing of Dogs on
Reservation of Penobscot Tribe of Indians."

Amend said Bill, in the 8th line of that part designated
"Sec. 2." of section 2 by drawing a line through the figure "\$1.15",
as follows: '~~\$1.15~~' and inserting immediately after said stricken
out figure the underlined figure '\$1.25'; and in the 9th line by
drawing a line through the figure "\$3.15", as follows: '~~\$3.15~~'
and inserting immediately after said stricken out figure the under-
lined figure '\$3.25'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 3."
of section 3 by striking out all of the last 2 lines and inserting
in place thereof the following: "into the fund for the municipal
purposes of said tribe, retaining to his own use ~~15¢~~ 25¢ for
each license issued.' "
