STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Justices of Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 103, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 370 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'The Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court shall each receive an annual salary of \$14,000 \$18,000, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court shall receive an annual salary of \$15,000 \$19,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 106, § 2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of chapter 106 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 68 of chapter 378 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'Each of the Justices of the Superior Court shall receive an annual salary of \$13,500 \$17,500.'

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 and the sum of \$60,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 to carry out the purposes of this act.
