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**AN ACT Relating to Adoption of Ordinances by Penobscot Tribe of Indians.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Adoption of ordinances by Penobscot Tribe of Indians.** The governor and council of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians shall prepare the ordinances, rules and regulations for the tribe after a hearing held at a special meeting of the tribe called for the purpose. Said ordinances, rules and regulations shall be submitted for approval by the tribe at a general meeting called by the governor.
